





Homily 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today Jesus offers a profound lesson on leadership and servanthood, which is central to Christian discipleship.

Jesus challenges the prevailing notion of authority in His time (and in ours). Worldly leadership is often characterized by power and dominance, but Jesus calls for a radical reversal of values. In the Kingdom of God, true greatness is measured by how much one serves others. Leaders, especially within the Church and Christian community, are called to be servants rather than seeking prestige or power.

The Lord presents Himself as the ultimate model for this servant-leadership. He came not to be served, but to serve. His life, culminating in His self-sacrificial death, is the perfect example of love and humility. We are called to follow Christ's example, especially through acts of charity, compassion, and selflessness in daily life.

The phrase "to give His life as a ransom for many" points to the redemptive purpose of Christ's mission. Jesus' death on the cross is the ultimate act of service — it is not just an example, but the means through which humanity is saved. For us, this has deep theological implications, especially in the Eucharist, where Christ's sacrifice is made present again and believers are invited to participate in that mystery. As Christ gave His life for others, we are called to make sacrifices in our own lives, offering up our sufferings for the good of others and for the salvation of souls.

The Gospel also speaks to the central Christian virtue of humility. In a culture that often glorifies personal achievement and status, Jesus teaches that true honor is found in humble service. For us, this humility is essential in our relationship with God and others. It is through humble service that we become more Christ-like, growing in holiness and preparing for eternal life.

My brothers and sisters, the gospel offers a powerful call to rethink what it means to be great in God's eyes. It challenges us to reject the pursuit of power and instead embrace a life of service, following Christ's example of humility, sacrifice, and love.
