Homily Passion (Palm) Sunday

Today we begin Holy Week with the celebration of Palm Sunday—the day we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, welcomed with palm branches and shouts of "Hosanna!" But just as quickly as the cheers fade, the Gospel brings us into the depths of His Passion. Such a sharp transformation occurs from glory to suffering. From the crowd's praise to their cries of "Crucify him!" It reminds us how quickly human hearts can turn when love is not rooted in truth.

In Luke's account of the Passion, we see Jesus remain silent before His accusers. He offers no defense, only love. We see Him forgive those who nail Him to the cross, offer paradise to a repentant thief, and entrust His Spirit into the Father's hands.

The liturgy of Palm Sunday asks us: Who are we in the story? Are we the crowd—faithful when it's easy, but absent at the cross? Are we like Peter—failing, but ultimately returning in tears? Or are we willing, like the good thief, to say, "Jesus, remember me"?

This week, let us walk with Jesus—not just in word, but in heart. Let our faith go beyond palms and into the passion. Let us carry our crosses with Him and so, finally, rise with Him to a new life.
